- Teach IVCC Introduction to Warehousing Course
 - **Course Description: WHS 1202 Introduction to Warehousing (1 semester hour credit).** Students will gain an understanding of warehousing fundamentals and the role warehousing plays in the logistical supply chain and in a global economy. Material will cover information essential to warehouse supervisors and management personnel.
 - Upon completion of the course, the student will be able to:
 - Define appropriate warehouse terminology.
 - Explain the role of warehousing in logistics, the supply chain and the economy.
 - Understand materials handling.
 - Understand safe dock procedures.
 - Identify and list various warehouse jobs.
 - Identify hazards specific to warehousing.
